NATIONAL ESTATE OF THE CHATEAU D'ANGERS AND THE APOCALYPSE TAPESTRY

Visit this 13th-century fortress and discover the monumental dungeon of the Apocalypse, spanning an impressive 103 metres! A masterpiece of medieval art, unique in the world!

Partial accessibility. Drop-off in front of the castle (use intercom to request access), with parking on Place Kennedy. Wheelchair access to the Gallery of the Apocalypse, the Governor's Lodge and the Chapel, with handrails along the stairs. Platform lift to the Gallery of the Apocalypse and lift to temporary exhibitions (Royal Lodge). Two wheelchairs available at the castle's reception, plus folding seats in the Gallery of the Apocalypse Tapestry. Rest areas available along the way. Adapted sanitary facilities.

Audio-guides with audio-induction loops available at the ticket office. Videos on the castle and the tapestry subtitled in French and French Sign Language. French Sign Language guided tours from September to June (upon reservation: minimum 5 people).

Throughout the year, tours of the site and its collections led by a tour guide: adapted commentary and sensory experiences (upon reservation: minimum 5 people).

Partial accessibility. Entrance through the Jardin des Beaux-Arts, 37 Rue Toussaint. Access to the gallery available on the left of the cloister. Accessible ground floor (about 70% of the tour), mezzanine not accessible.

Tour materials. Guided tours in French Sign Language (upon reservation: minimum 8 people).

Adapted cultural activities and workshops for children, young people and adults (upon reservation: minimum 8 people)\*.

REPAIRE URBAIN

The RU cultural hub hosts three services: Angers Patrimoines, the Artothèque art library and the Heritage Archives. It also hosts an Architecture and Heritage Interpretation Centre, temporary exhibitions, a reading room and more.

Fully accessible. Adapted parking available to the right of the entrance to the Jardin des Beaux-Arts, 35 Boulevard du Roi René. Lift. Adapted sanitary facilities.

Audio-induction loop at reception.

Tactile models and guided tours on appointment (minimum 5 people). Tours offered as part of the Angers Patrimoines calendar of events.

MUSEUM OF FINE ARTS

In the heart of a beautiful square, this museum has been housed in the private mansion of the Barrault lodge (15th century) since 1796. Here, you can discover some superb exhibitions over the museum's 3,000 m².

Fully accessible. Place Saint-Eloi (+33 (0)2 41 05 38 71), automatic doors and lift on the garden side of the Museum of Fine Arts. Loan of wheelchairs and folding chairs. Adapted sanitary facilities.

Free audio-guides and auditorium with audio-induction loop. Tour materials. Guided tour in French Sign Language scheduled for exhibitions or upon reservation, one month in advance (minimum 8 people)\*.

Adapted cultural activities and workshops for children, young people and adults (upon reservation: minimum 8 people).

COLLEGIATE CHURCH OF SAINT-MARTIN

Why not take the time to visit one of the best preserved Carolingian monuments in France?

Partial accessibility. Loan of wheelchairs and walking-stick chairs. Adapted sanitary facilities accessible via the lift. Adapted tours (upon reservation: minimum 8 people). Site entirely on one level, except for the archaeological crypt (14 steps).

Subtitled video on archaeological remains. Archaeological windows visible from the ground floor.

Audio-guides with audio-induction loop. Tour leaflets. Subtitled videos presenting the archaeological crypt and statues. Group tours in French Sign Language (upon reservation at least one month in advance, minimum 10 people). Outdoor-location map.

Sensory guided tours (upon reservation: minimum 5 people). Individual support possible according to availability or by appointment.

SAINT-MAURICE CATHEDRAL

Admire this 11th-century building and discover the Gothic Angevin style, its statues, vaults and medieval stained-glass windows – the oldest of which dates back to 1165!

Partial accessibility: access through the side entrance on Place Freppe – located on the left, upon entrance to the courtyard.

Accompanying tour leaflet and information panels.
